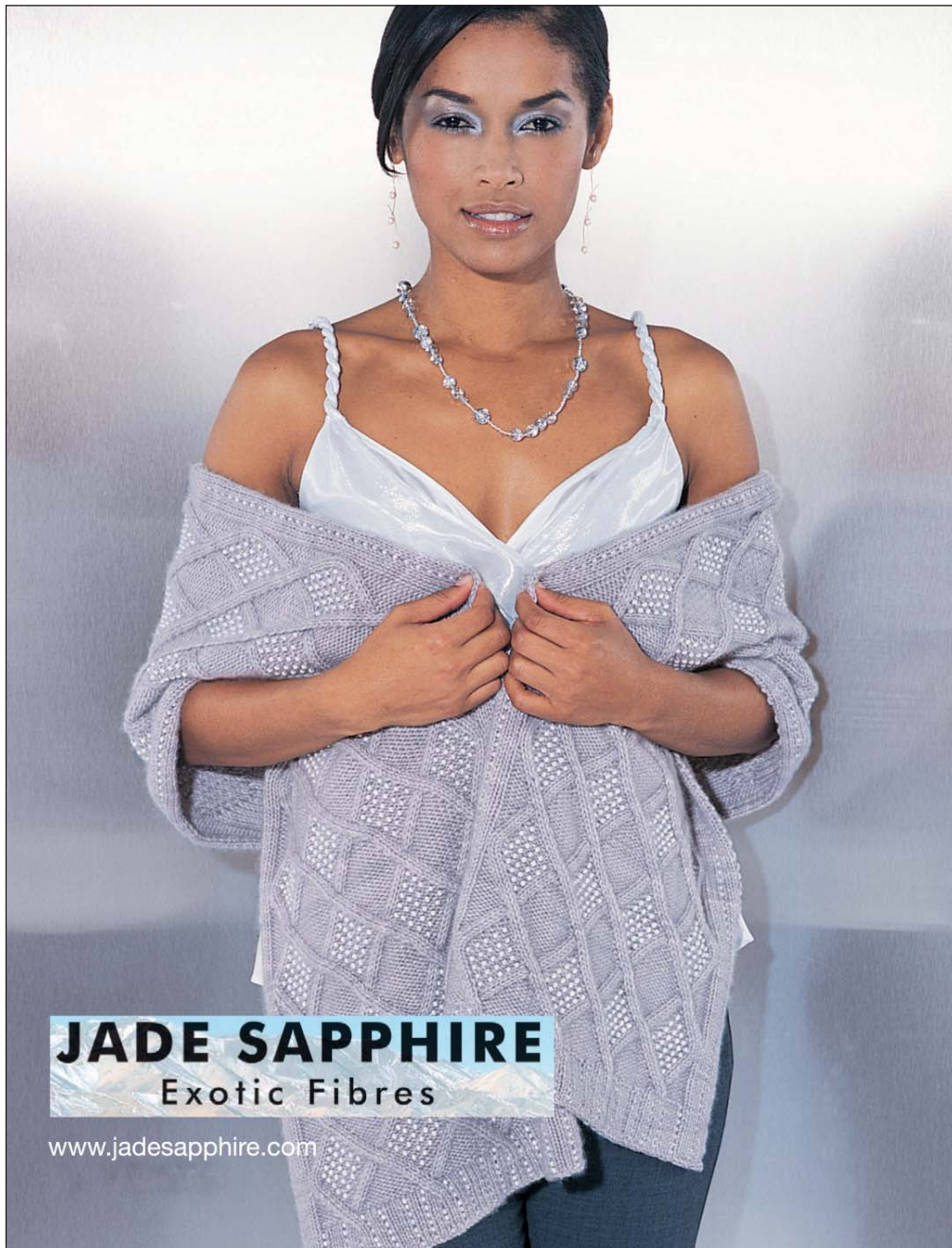


JADE SAPPHIRE EXOTIC FIBRES

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Diamonds and Pearls Stole

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Materials

7 Skeins Jade Sapphire Mongolian Cashmere 6-ply
Approx. 3000 Size 6 Miyuki Seed Beads
8 knitting needles
Cable needle

Description of Stole as shown:

Jade Sapphire Colorway: Sterling
White Pearl Ceylon Seed Beads
Finished measurements approx. 72" long x 13 ½" wide
21 (24-row diamond pattern) repeats

Each full skein of yarn knits up to approximately 10 inches of stole.

Stitches

K-Knit

P-Purl

◊-Slip stitch purlwise and push bead in front of slipped stitch

5LC-Slip 3 Stitches to cable needle and hold in front of work, K2, slip 1 stitch back to left hand needle and P the stitch, K2 from cable needle

3LC-Slip 2 stitches to cable needle and hold in front of work, P1, K2 from cable needle

3RC-Slip 1 stitch to cable needle and hold in back of work, K2, P1 from cable needle

Beading Technique

This pattern calls for the knitter to string a supply of beads onto the yarn prior to knitting. To do this, tie a piece of sewing thread approximately 6 inches from the beginning of the skein of yarn. Thread a needle that is small enough to fit through the holes in the beads onto the sewing thread. Thread beads onto the needle and push them down the sewing thread and onto the yarn. We recommend that you knit in half skeins so you will not have to slide as many beads up and down the yarn during the knitting process. Knitting will proceed faster and it will be gentler on the yarn. The pattern uses approximately 154 beads for the ribbing and 126 beads per diamond repeat. There are approximately 3 24-row diamond pattern repeats per 10 inches of stole.

All beads are slipped onto purl stitches on the right side of work as follows: Work to where the bead should be placed, slip stitch purlwise, push bead in front of slipped purl stitch, work next stitch as indicated in pattern. The bead should rest in front of the slipped purl stitch and sit comfortably in between the two stitches that surround it.

To Begin

String beads onto yarn
Cast on 79 stitches

Ribbing

Row 1 (RS): K4, ◇, K3, ◇, K3, (◇, K2) 3 times, ◇, K3, (◇, K2) four times, ◇, K3, (◇, K2) four times, ◇, K3, (◇, K2) three times, ◇, K3, ◇, K3, ◇, K4

Row 2 (WS): knit all the Knit stitches and purl all the Purl stitches. The slipped ◇ stitch on the RS is a K on the wrong side.

Repeat Ribbing Rows 1 & 2 six more times for a total of 14 rows of ribbing ending on a WS.

Begin Diamond and Pearls Pattern—24 row repeat

Row 1 (RS): K4, ◇, K3, P5, (5LC, P11) 3 times, 5LC, P5, K3, ◇, K4

Row 2 and all WS rows: knit the Knit stitches and purl the Purl stitches

Row 3: K4, ◇, K3, P4, (3RC, P1, 3LC, P9) 3 times, 3RC, P1, 3LC, P4, K3, ◇, K4

Row 5: K4, ◇, K3, P3, (3RC, P1, ◇, P1, 3LC, P7) 3 times, 3RC, P1, ◇, P1, 3LC, P3, K3, ◇, K4

Row 7: K4, ◇, K3, P2, (3RC, P1, ◇, P1, ◇, P1, 3LC, P5), 3 times, 3RC, P1, ◇, P1, ◇, P1, 3LC, P2, K3, ◇, K4

Row 9: K4, ◇, K3, P1, (3RC, P1, ◇, P1, ◇, P1, ◇, 3LC, P3) 3 times, 3RC, P1, ◇, P1, ◇, P1, ◇, 3LC, P1, K3, ◇, K4

Row 11: K4, ◇, K3, (3RC, P1, ◇, P1, ◇, P1, ◇, P1, ◇, P1, 3LC, P1) 3 times, 3RC, P1, ◇, P1, ◇, P1, ◇, P1, ◇, P1, 3LC, K3, ◇, K4

Row 13: K4, ◇, K5, (P1, ◇, P1, ◇, P1, ◇, P1, ◇, P1, ◇, P1, ◇, P1, 5LC) 3 times, P1, ◇, P1, ◇, P1, ◇, P1, ◇, P1, ◇, P1, K5, ◇, K4

Row 15: K4, ◇, K3, (3LC, P1, ◇, P1, ◇, P1, ◇, P1, ◇, P1, 3RC, P1) 3 times, 3LC, P1, ◇, P1, ◇, P1, ◇, P1, ◇, P1, 3RC, K3, ◇, K4

Row 17: K4, ◇, K3, P1, (3LC, P1, ◇, P1, ◇, P1, ◇, P1, 3RC, P3) 3 times, 3LC, P1, ◇, P1, ◇, P1, ◇, P1, 3RC, P1, K3, ◇, K4

Row 19: K4, ◇, K3, P2, (3LC, P1, ◇, P1, ◇, P1, 3RC, P5) 3 times, 3LC, P1, ◇, P1, ◇, P1, 3RC, P2, K3, ◇, K4

Row 21: K4, ◇, K3, P3, (3LC, P1, ◇, P1, 3RC, P7) 3 times, 3LC, P1, ◇, P1, 3RC, P3, K3, ◇, K4

Row 23: K4, ◇, K3, P4, (3LC, P1, 3RC, P9) 3 times, 3LC, P1, 3RC, P4, K3, ◇, K4

Row 24: knit all the Knit stitches and purl the Purl stitches

Repeat Rows 1-24 twenty-one times or how ever many times for your desired stole length.

End on a Row 24 (WS). On next RS repeat Rows 1 and 2 of ribbing pattern seven times. Bind off on last WS row.

Block finished stole. Enjoy it!!!
